## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PICKLE LAKE

## **BY-LAW 2008-14**

## BEING A BY-LAW TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION FOR PROVISION OF MUNCIPAL ROAD AND CAPITAL INVESTMENT NEEDS

**WHEREAS** under Section 9 of the Municipal Act 2001, as amended, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 10 (2), 7 authorizes a single-tier Municipality to pass a by-law for services or things that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake wishes to enter into an Agreement with the Ministry of Transportation to provide funds for municipal road and bridge capital investment needs;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake *ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:* 

- 1. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the Corporation to enter into an agreement.
- 2. **THAT** the attached letter Schedule "A", "Re: 2008 Municipal Road and Bridge Infrastructure," from Minister Jim Bradley is a part of this By-Law;
- 3. **THAT** \$125,933 allocated to the Township of Pickle Lake by the Province will be used for municipal road and bridge capital needs;
- 43. **THAT** a final summary report detailing expenditures, use of provincial funding, and outcomes achieved shall be submitted to the Ministry, and the Ministry may request an independent audit of the project, and;
- 5. **THAT** any funds intended for a project that are not used in accordance with rehabilitation of municipal road and bridge capital investment needs or the terms outlined above will be returned to the Ministry.
- 3. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force at the time of passing.
