BY-LAW NO. 2012-17

BEING A BY-LAW TO BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A PROPERTY STANDARDS OFFICER

WHEREAS Section 227 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c25 as amended, provides that the Councils of every municipality may appoint such officers and employees as may be necessary for the purpose of the Corporation, or for carrying into effect any Act of the Legislature or by-law of the Council, and fixing their remuneration and prescribing their duties, and the security to be given for the performance of them.

AND WHEREAS By-law 2004-08, being a by-law for prescribing standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property within the Township of Pickle Lake; for prohibiting the occupancy or use of such property that does not conform to the standards; and for requiring property that does not conform with the standards to be repaired and maintained to conform with the standards of for the land to be cleared of all buildings, structures, debris or refuse and left in a graded and level position with the Township of Pickle Lake was passed by Council on November 23, 2004;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake deems it necessary and expedient to appoint a Property Standards Officer to enforce By-law No. 2004-08:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Charles Tarrant be and is hereby appointed Property Standards Officer for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake;
2. That the said Charles Tarrant shall hold office during the pleasure of the Council, and subject to the by-laws of the Council, shall, with respect to the Township of Pickle Lake and the administration of its affairs, exercise all the authority, powers and rights and shall perform all duties and obligations which by statute or by-law are or may be to be conferred or imposed upon the Property Standards Officer and any other duties as may be imposed by Council or the Property Standards Committee from time to time.
3. That By-Law 86 – 23 is hereby rescinded.
4. That remuneration for the said Charles Tarrant shall be \$55.00 per hour and mileage shall be paid at a rate of \$0.50 per kilometer.

BY-LAW BE READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED.
