BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2013-26
BEING A BY-LAW TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH THE NORTHERN ONTARIO HERITAGE FUND
CORPORATION A CORPORATION EXISTING UNDER
THE LAWS OF ONTARIO HEREIN AFTER REFERRED
TO AS "NOHFC" TO UPGRADE MUNICIPALLY OWNED
AND OPERATED INTERNET HARDWARE

WHEREAS under Section 9 of the Municipal Act 2001, as amended a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 10 (2), 7 authorizes a single-tier Municipality to pass a by-law for services or things that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

AND WHEREAS NOHFC has prepared a Contribution Agreement providing support of up to \$31,580.00 (Thirty-one Thousand and Five Hundred and Eighty dollars), towards the upgrade to municipally owned and operated internet hardware;

AND WHEREAS the early onset of extreme winter temperatures along with the remoteness of the geographical location of Pickle Lake, Ontario has created a condition in which an extension of the time limits of the original agreement was necessary in order to complete the scope of work;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PICKLE LAKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the Corporation to enter into the Contribution Agreement.
- 2. **THAT** the Agreement attached hereto and marked as Schedule "A", is part of this By-Law.
- 3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force upon the date of signing.
