6.1. Mayor & Councillor Millar had no report. Councillor Dunbabin asked about water and sewer rates asking if businesses are being charged properly according to the by-law. Councillor Millar asked how many units there were at the Pickle Lake Hotel. Councillor Dunbabin requested that the businesses be inspected and a report of the number of units be developed, Councillor Millar suggested that a committee be formed to complete this task.
