BY-LAW NO. 2017-07

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF PICKLE LAKE WASTE DISPOSAL SITE

WHEREAS Section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act* 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;


AND WHEREAS Section 10(1) provides that a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public.


AND WHEREAS Section 41 of the Environment Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990 provides that no person shall use, or cause, permit or arrange for the use of, any facilities or equipment for the storage, handling, treatment, collection, transportation, processing or disposal of waste that is not part of a waste management system for which an environmental compliance approval or renewable energy approval has been issued or a registration under Part II.2 is in effect and except in accordance with the terms and conditions of the approval or the regulations made for the purposes of Part II.2.

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** only permitted hazardous substances will be disposed of in the Township of Pickle Lake Waste Disposal Site.
2. **THAT** all hazardous substances must be disposed of in the designated location at the site.
4. **THAT** Schedule A-Fees; Schedule B- Hazardous and Waste Oil Notice; Schedule C- Permitted and Not Permitted Substances; are included in this By-law.

HAZARDOUS AND WASTE OIL-NOTICE

Hazardous and Waste Oil
Generators

The Waste Management Branch of the Ministry of Environment has brought it to our attention that a number of local liquid waste generators in Pickle Lake are depositing waste oil and other liquids in the Municipal Dump Site. This is not permitted! All waste generators should have a generator number and must use a certified carrier to transport their liquid waste to a designated reclaim site.

SCHEDULE C**PERMITTED AND NOT PERMITTED HAZARDOUS SUSTANCES****Permitted**

1. Light Fuels – gas and diesel, spill clean-up residue.
2. Heavy Fuels – asphalt, tank drainings, spill clean-up residue.

Not Permitted

1. Waste oil;
2. Batteries;
3. Corrosive substances – i.e. acids;
4. Explosives;
5. Unidentified substances;
6. Compressed gases – including cylinders; and
7. Arsenic and heavy metal tailings.
