Local health clinic offers wide range of services



The Pickle Lake Health Clinic Unit is a modern facility which boasts an emergency treatment room and regular patient services, for the residents of the Pickle Lake and Mishkeegogamang First Nation area. The Health Clinic comprises of a doctor, a nurse and a medical receptionist.

The Health Clinic houses a fully equipped dental office with two dental chairs, a fitness centre and the Northwest Health

The Health Clinic works with regional medical providers in order to expand on patient care services such as blood collection and testing, prescription dispensation and emergency health services. 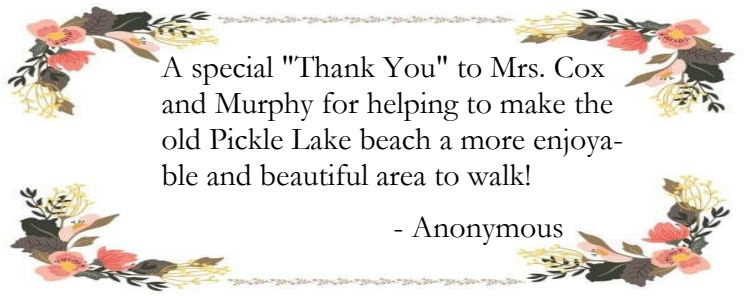

Federal and Provincial Grants Help to Revitalize Kapkichi

On Wednesday, September 13 the Township of Pickle Lake welcomed members of the public to a ribbon-cutting ceremony to mark the re-opening of the Kapkichi Lake waterfront. Local MP Bob Nault was on hand to congratulate members of the Township on the work done with support from the Ontario 150 Community Capital Program and the Canada 150 Community Infrastructure Program.

The waterfront revitalization project includes an upgraded, structurally sound pier, a new boat launch and the addition of accessible floating docks. The revitalization of the waterfront also allows for a safe and accessible recreation facility for activities by local organizations and groups.

"This upgraded waterfront facility is an important infrastructure investment which helps make Pickle Lake a great place to work, live and play," said Sarah Campbell, MPP for Kenora-Rainy River "It will also serve as an accessible gathering place for all area residents to enjoy the outdoors and all that Northwestern Ontario has to offer.
