9.1. New Tecumseth, Ontario Carbon Tax (tabled June 27, 2017)

WHEREAS the Provincial Government passed legislation known as the Climate Change Mitigation and Low-Carbon Economy Act, 2016, S.O.2016, c.7 including Reg. 144/16 the Cap and Trade Program Reg. 143/16 Quantification, Reporting and Verification of Greenhouse Gas Emission;

AND WHEREAS on January 1, 2017 the Province of Ontario adopted a cap-and-trade carbon pricing system which provides for the inclusion of a carbon fee for users of products derived from carbon-based fuels;

AND WHEREAS the terms of the Ontarian Energy Board ruling stated that the carbon fee will be included in the 'delivery' line of natural gas bills and not listed separately;

THERREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council for the Corporation of The Township of Pickle Lake requests the Government of Ontario insist that all bills from companies supplying products derived from carbon-based fuels including, but not limited to products such as natural gas, propane, hydro, gasoline and furnace oil, to Ontario residents show the carbon fee/tax on a separate line of the bill;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Province of Ontario be required to report annually to Ontario Citizens on the proceeds of the carbon tax;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution be forwarded to Ontario's Premier and Minister of Energy, MPP Sarah Campbell, the AMO and the Council for the Town of New Tecumseth.

WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of The Township of Pickle Lake has completed a Community Profile and Asset Inventory, both of which form the basis of the long term planning required for community development;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of The Township of Pickle Lake has identified three further studies which are required to be undertaken to ensure economic growth and investment attraction;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake hereby supports the request for funding assistance to the Ministry Northern Development and Mines, Communities Investment Readiness Program (NCIR), for the creation of three studies namely, a Market Plan – Sector Analysis, a Needs and Gaps Analysis and a Strategic Plan, each study application will be in the amount of \$9,327 (75% of project costs) with the total study cost being \$12,436.00 with the Township commitment of up to 25% funding to a maximum amount of \$3,109. The total of the three studies will cost \$37,308 with total funding requested from NCIR to be \$27,981 with the Township committing a total of \$9,327.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake hereby accepts responsibility for all cost overruns the project incurs.
