  - 6.1.3.3. Central Patricia study given go-ahead with a provincial investment in excess of \$300,000. Included in the work is the deployment of a specialized aircraft to produce ground density maps, highlighting mine drifts, stopes and shafts. The project may also involve the removal of the deteriorated headframe. As well, the current restriction of 500 m. radius from the headframe as a nodevelopment zone will be revisited.
