- Hydro One is looking for lodging in Pickle Lake for its employees for several months, which the Mayor has deferred to the Economic Development Department.
 - Ms MacKenzie reported having checked for vacancies at hotels and rental homes in the community and forwarded information to Hydro One. Township-owned property could be used as a last resort, but not in competition with local businesses.
- Provincial Ring of Fire road-building plans may change as the province is considering to let the region's First Nations determine the route. Sioux Lookout EDO has been informed, as it may effect plans for the Town's plans to serve as a regional transportation terminus.

- Residents have raised the issue of dogs running at large and attacking other pets on private property.
