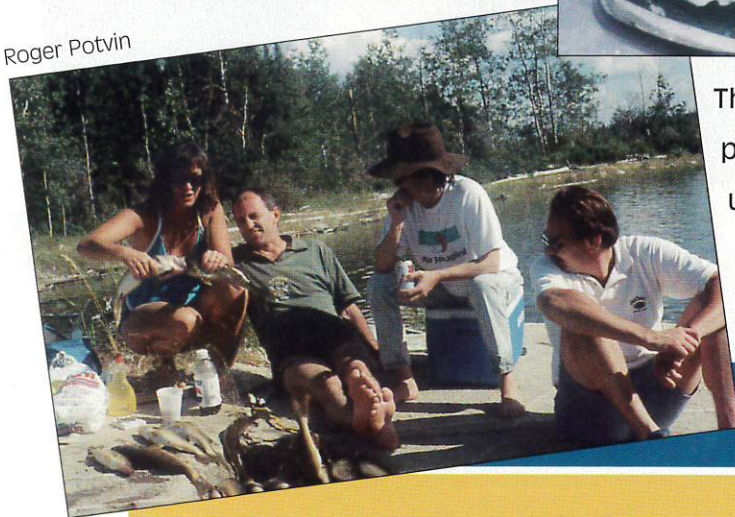

Recreation enthusiasts may also choose to take advantage of our RV park which has beachfront access and hydro hook-ups.

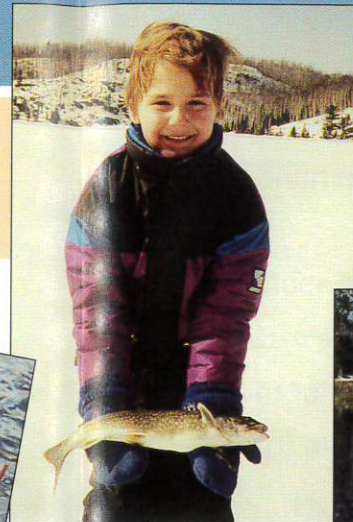
The **Pickle Lake** area is the starting point for adventuresome canoeists desiring to paddle to Hudson/James Bay, the Winisk

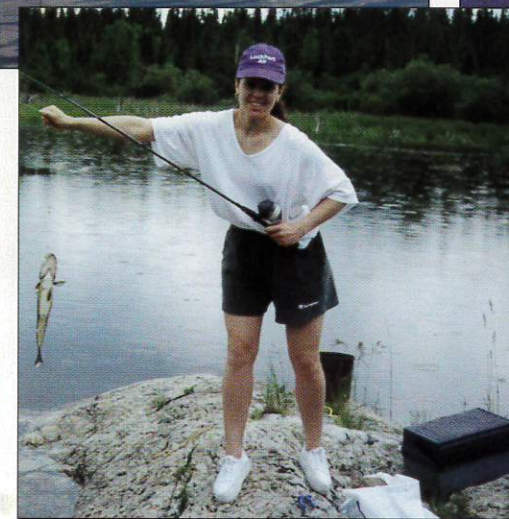

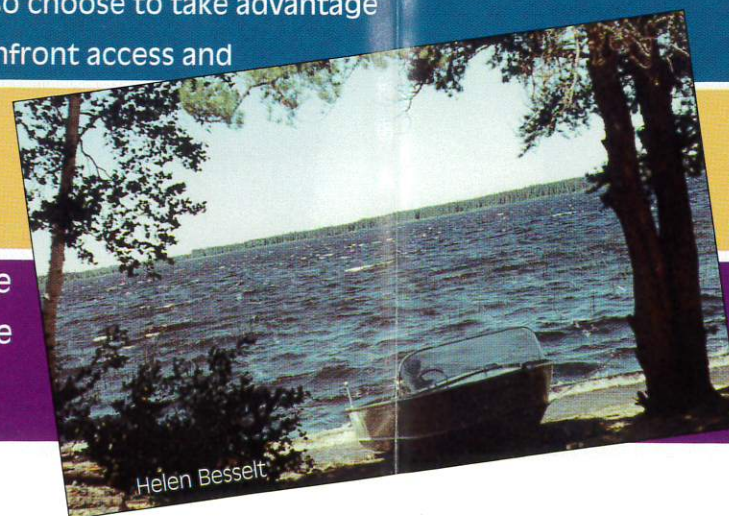

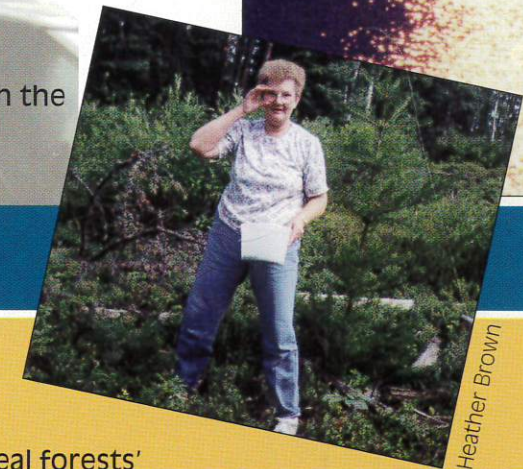

abundance of rare plants, wild herbs and vegetation. Come and pick wild mushrooms and wild rice...a gourmet's delight!

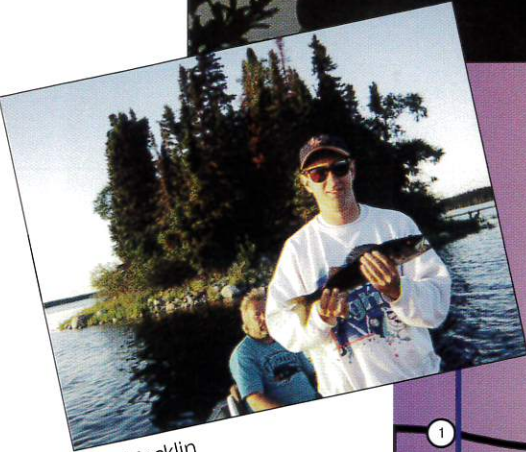

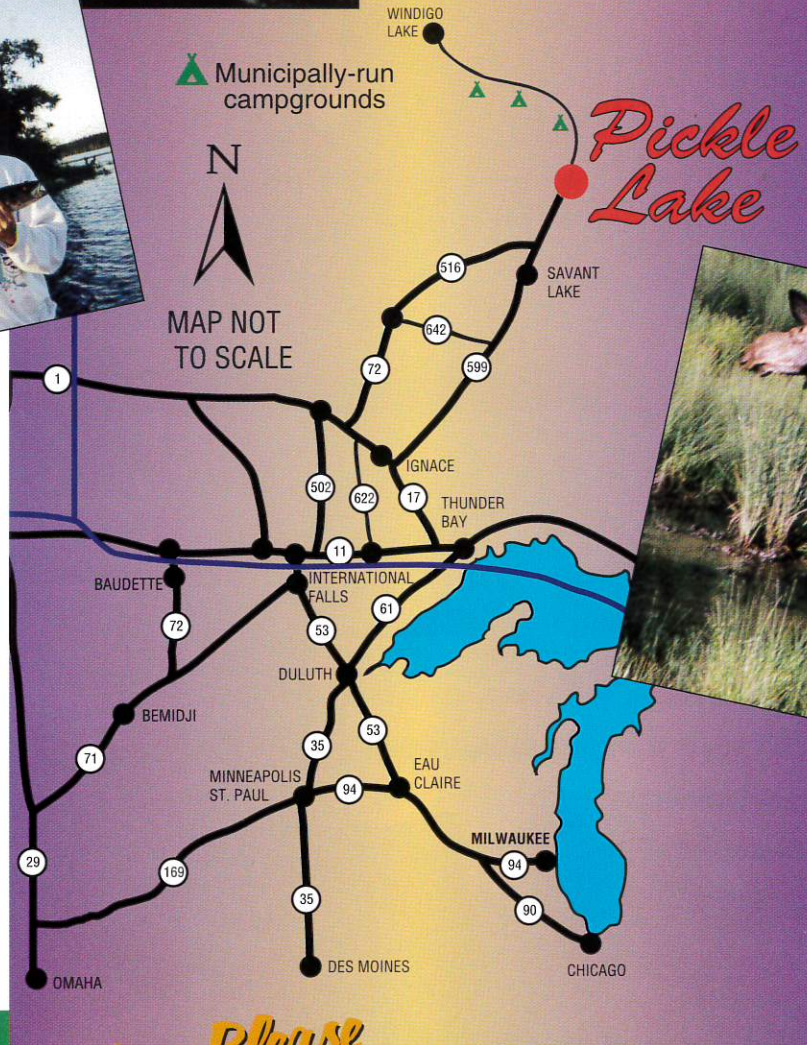
