- -No further issues with checkpoint at this time.

#### 3.4 Nurse Johnson

- -No major changes, some PPE still backordered.
- -Travel outside the region recommendation by NWHU is to wear masks upon return or isolate for 14 days. .

# 3.6 Mayor Monck

- Walbourne and Monck to work checkpoint in Mishkeegogamang Tuesday May 12, Blakney and Labine to work afternoon/evening shift.
- -Nurse PJ arrived today and starts Tuesday May 12th, 2020.

#### 3.7 Clerk Treasurer Jamie Hussey

- Funding announced for EarlyOn and family center to provide sustainability for these spaces when they reopen.

- -Any municipal COVID enforcement must be reported weekly to Ministry of Solicitor General.
- -Reopening of ServiceOntario/Municipal Office May 19<sup>th</sup>, and council meeting in council chambers provided the EMPCA is not extended into June.
- -Cleaning, disinfecting, appropriate signage etc to be posted if reopening occurs.
- -Premier has called on Rickford to investigate the 20-30% higher gas prices in NWO.

Council will be permitted to meet in person provided the Provincial Emergency Order has been lifted.
