**THEREFORE** The Council for the Corporation of The Township of Pickle Lake hereby agrees that in order for the project to be of financial fitness for all those involved, extending the temporary camp from 3 years to 5 years is necessary.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake hereby agrees that the temporary camp allowance will be extended until October 14, 2025.
