BY-LAW NO. 2021-14



BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A CONSOLIDATED FEE BY-LAW FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF PICKLE LAKE

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, 2001, Part XII, Section 391, as amended, provides that a municipality may impose fees or charges (a) for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it, (b) for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board, and (c) for the use of its property including property under its control.

AND WHEREAS Section 69(1) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P13 provides that the Council of a municipality, by by-law may prescribe a tariff of fees for the processing of applications made in respect of planning matters, which tariff shall be designed to meet only the anticipated cost to the municipality or to a committee of adjustment or land division committee constituted by the council of the municipality or to the planning board in respect of the processing of each type of application provided for in the tariff;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake deems it necessary and expedient to consolidate all fees charged for administration purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, The council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the fees and charges for each department shall be the amount set forth in the attached Schedules hereto forming part of this by-law:
 - a) Schedule "A" - Administration/Business
 - b) Schedule "B" - Planning
 - c) Schedule "C" - Building Department
 - d) Schedule "D" - Licenses
 - e) Schedule "E" - Tax Sales Act
 - f) Schedule "F" - Parks and Recreation
 - g) Schedule "G" - Waste Disposal/Hazardous Substances
 - h) Schedule "H" - Water and Sewer
 - i) Schedule "I" - Cemetery
2. **THAT** By-law No. 2018-06 is rescinded.
3. **THAT** amounts and by-laws inconsistent with this by-law are hereby rescinded and replaced by the schedules in this by-law.
4. **THAT** fees may be increased or decreased from time to time as required by resolution of the Council, or as incorporated into the budget estimates for any year.
5. **THAT** this by-law comes into force and takes effect as of passing.

BE READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS
