The New Pickle Connecting Link is officially open effective April 4th, 2022 for heavy truck traffic.

We have been patiently awaiting the official permit opening for our Airport Road Extension. The Road is named in accordance with the current road name it connects with "Airport Road". We want to stress that this road is meant to eliminate heavy truck traffic carrying dangerous goods destined for the Pickle Lake Airport from the downtown core. This road is to be used primarily for airport traffic, including EMS patient transfers. This road will also be utilized as an emergency evacuation route for the community in the event of an emergency. Please note the speed limit for this road is 40 km/hr. The road is currently at a base level gravel. The urgency in opening the road at the base gravel for use is by design to allow for compaction prior to granular "B" being placed and finally surface treatment. We are warning motorists that this road will periodically be closed down for additional construction activities. The current surfacing is rough as compaction takes effect. Please exercise caution and drive the speed limit. Your co-operation in ensuring this route is used primarily for airport traffic is appreciated as the airport road does travel through high volume areas of semi-trucks unloading and passenger traffic moving in and out of parking lots. Thank you for your co-operation and support as we begin to work toward the next phase of completion.
