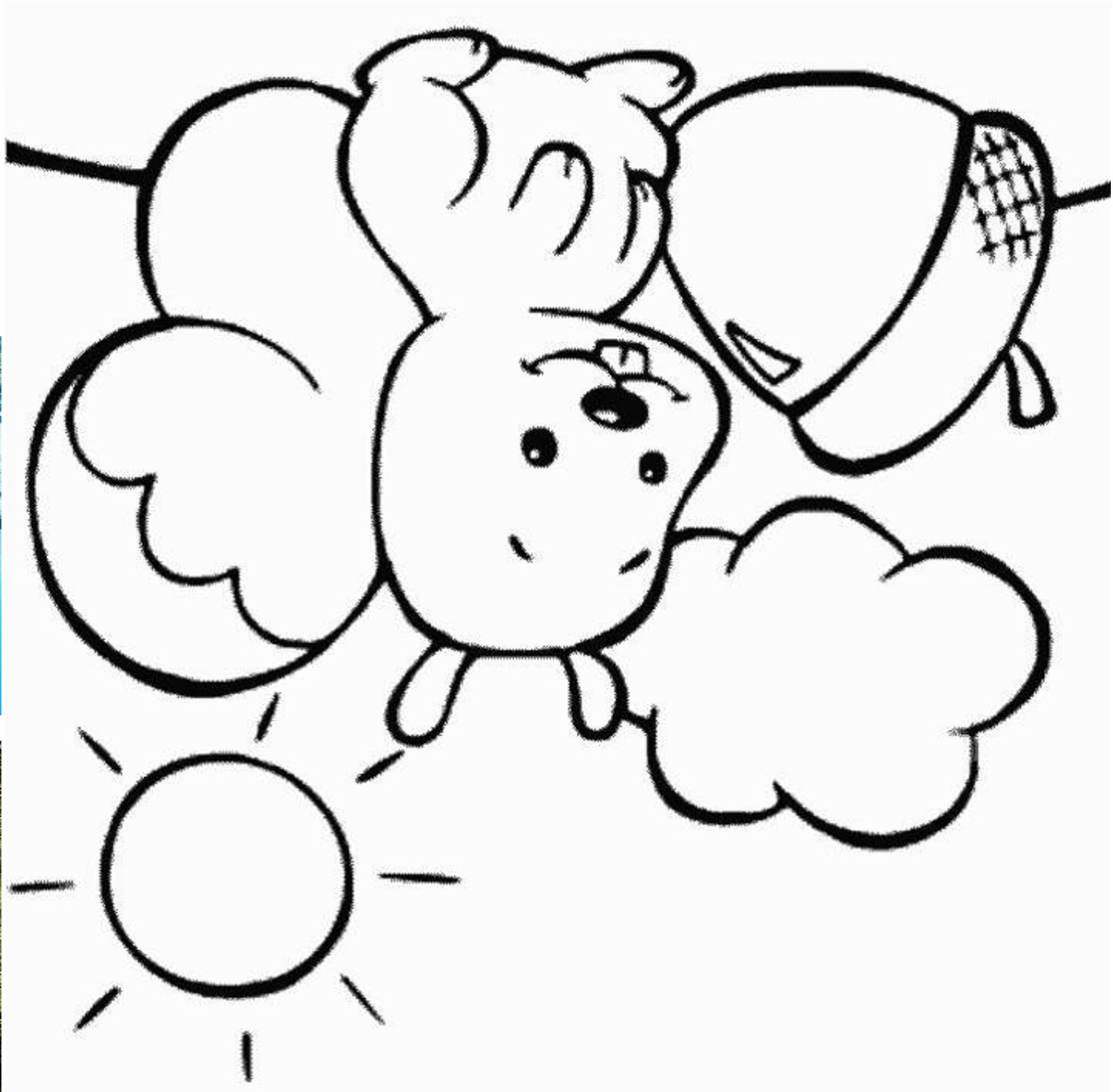


# The Lakeside Bulletin



Pickle Lake's new and improved airport access route is making progress. Within the next few weeks the base gravel will be open to heavy trucks destined to the Pickle Lake Airport. This extension will allow for the elimination of hazardous materials such as fuel destined for the airport in our downtown core. It will also provide an emergency access route to the airport for air medical transport. Additionally, we are thankful for having a secondary exit from the community in the event of a full scale evacuation. Thank you to our contractor Moncrieff Construction for a job well done thus far. We look forward to the placement of final granular and paving in the coming months. We are grateful for the critical funding from the Provincial and Federal Governments that have made this critical piece of infrastructure possible. Stay tuned for more updates in the future!

February 23, 2022

TAKE NOTE THAT the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake is updating their Official Plan pursuant to Section 26 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13 as amended (the Planning Act) with the goal of creating a new Draft Official Plan for the community.

The Township will be holding a Public Meeting as required by Section 17(15) of the Planning Act, to introduce the community to the Official Plan project and provide the community an opportunity to share their views on land use planning and the new Draft Official Plan policies for Pickle Lake.

The current Township of Pickle Lake Official Plan is 20 years old, and the principles, goals, objectives, and policies intended to guide future land use and the physical development are inconsistent and do not conform with the current Planning Act Regulations including the Provincial Policy Statement and Provincial Plans.

The Public Meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to ask questions to staff and consultants about the new Draft Official Plan as it relates to changes in the community.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The new Draft Official Plan is available for review at the Municipal Office located at 2 Anne Street South, weekdays between 8:00am to 12:00pm, 12:30pm to 4:30pm. A copy of the new Draft Official Plan is available on the Municipality's website at <https://picklelake.ca>

**NOTE:** Should you wish to receive notice of future Public Hearings for the new Draft Official Plan, you must write to the Clerk requesting such, including your address. Should you wish to receive Notice of Adoption, you must file with the Clerk a written request to be notified. **ALSO NOTE:** Any person or public body will be entitled to receive Notice of Decision of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing if a written request to be notified of the decision is made to the Minister. Any requests shall include the person's or public body's name and address. Requests for Notice of Decision shall be submitted to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and housing, Municipal Service Office – Sudbury, 156 Cedar Street, Suite 401, Sudbury, ON P3E 6A5.

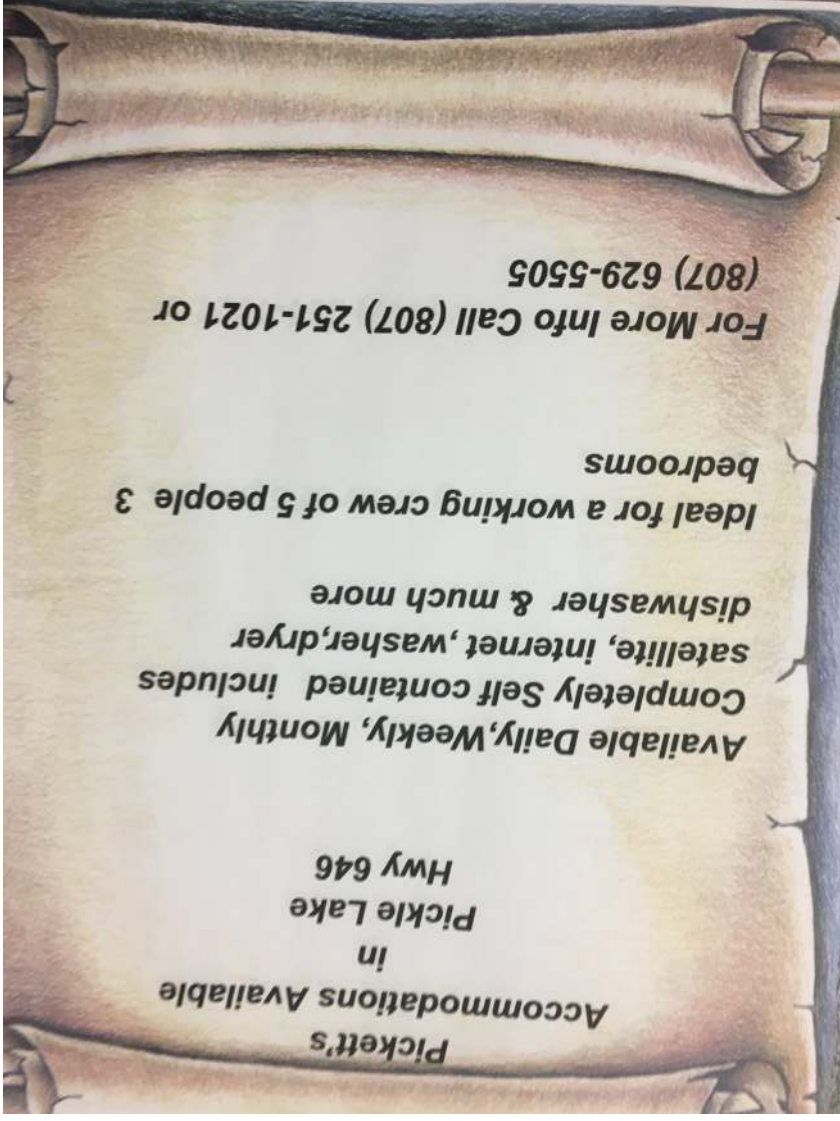
