

The Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake

By-Law 2023-29

Being a By-Law to Appoint a Deputy Mayor for the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake.

WHEREAS Section 242 of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipality may, by by-law or resolution, appoint a member of the council to act in the place of the head of council or other member of council designate to preside at meeting in the municipality's procedure by by-law when the head of council or designated member is absent or refuses to act or the office is vacant, while so acting such member has all the powers and duties of the head of council or designated member, as the case may be, with respect to the role of presiding at meetings; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake deems it advisable to appoint a Deputy Mayor.


NOW THEREFORE: the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake enacts as follows:

- 1) **THAT, Councillor Deborah Chartrand** is appointed Deputy Mayor for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake for a term starting October 10, 2023, and ending July 10, 2024.
- 2) **THAT, Councillor Kayla Blakney** is appointed Deputy Mayor for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake for a term starting July 11, 2024 and ending April 12, 2025.
- 3) **THAT, Councillor Leslie Moore** is appointed Deputy Mayor for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake for a term starting April 13, 2025, and ending January 14, 2026.
- 4) **THAT, Councillor John Millar** is appointed Deputy Mayor for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake for a term starting January 15, 2026, and ending November __, 2026.
- 5) **THAT,** in the absence of the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor shall fulfill all obligations of the Mayor, as set out in the Municipal Act, 2001, the Emergency Management & Civil Protection Act, and any other applicable legislation, and shall have all the powers and duties of the Mayor.
- 6) **THAT,** this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the final passage thereof.
