

The Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake

By-Law 2024-14

Being a By-Law to appoint members to the Ontario Provincial Police Detachment Board - Sioux Lookout OPP Detachment as per Community Safety & Police Act which will come into effect April 1,2024.

Council for the Corporation of the Township of Pickle Lake hereby appoints Councillor, John Millar to the newly formed joint OPP Detachment Board – Sioux Lookout OPP Detachment effective April 1,2024 as per the new Ontario Community Safety and Policing Act (CSPA) that will come in to force on April 1,2024.

THAT, Council receive and accept the correspondence from Mayor Doug Lawrance, Corporation of the Municipality of Sioux Lookout dated March 04,2024 regarding the transition from Police Service Boards to OPP Detachment Board – Sioux Lookout OPP Detachment, at the Regular Meeting of Council this 26th day of March 2024, as presented.

AND FURTHER THAT, Council appointments the following members Councillor, John Millar Chartrand and Community member Robert Rasmussen, to the newly appointed legislated OPP Detachment Board as per the Ontario Community Safety and Policing Act (CSPA).


AND FURTHER THAT, Council of the Township of Pickle Lake authorizes the Municipality of Sioux Lookout to take the lead on the arrangements for the transition from Police Services Boards to an OPP Detachment Board.

AND FURTHER THAT, Council approves in principle that the “administrative headquarters” of the new OPP Detachment Board be the Sioux Lookout Municipal Office. Final approval, if approval, is desired, will have to be given by the new Board once it is fully operational.


AND FURTHER THAT, Council authorizes the Municipality of Sioux Lookout to proceed with developing and drafting the “Rules of Procedure” required by Section 46 of the CSPA, governing how the Board will operate, as “proposals” to be submitted to and reviewed by the Township upon completion. To clarify, Sioux Lookout will propose details such as frequency of meeting, meeting method, apportionment of Board operating costs, Board member compensation, etc., for review by Pickle Lake. Any changes can be made and/or discussed. These would be “draft” Rules of Procedures since final approval will still have to be given by the new Board once it is fully constituted and operational (after training).
