Beginning in January, it was clear that a suicide crisis started to occur in the community of Mishkeegogamang, affecting the lives of the youth. This crisis has since started to impact on our community and our youth as well in Pickle Lake. Due to this, it allowed me to think about what was crucially important to focus on, whether that was continuing what I am already doing or partnering up with programs from Mishkeegogamang to help promote suicide prevention and bullying awareness through various events highlighting the importance of embracing your inner child. More importantly, me and the three programs, plus the interested and willing volunteers, all agreed that it was our duty to focus on the mental health and wellbeing of all of our youth combined.

Both communities want to advocate the importance of why focusing on the youth and their families is crucial in the current time. Each programmer views this crisis as an opportunity to unite our youth and remind them why their lives are important. More importantly, remind the youth that they have a whole future ahead of them, because truthfully, they are our future.

To promote suicide prevention, while spreading awareness of our current issues in both of our communities, we want to focus on the importance of certain events that include outdoor activities, brainstorming, and more. Those events include skating, sports, art and crafts, hands-on activities, and more.

The first event between the partnership among events takes place at the Pickle Lake Community Hall on Friday, February 21 from 5PM to 7PM, with Jordan's Principle. This event focuses on **embracing your inner child**. Transportation will be provided but limited.
